MCA, TANA take up typhoid vaccination programme

GUNTUR: Repalle-based Medical and Cultural Association (MCA) has taken up relief measures on a large scale in association with several organisations as part of the flood relief programmes.

One of the major work being done now is vaccinating children for typhoid with the active participation of the Telugu Association of North America (TANA), which has given \$ 10,000 immediately and has promised more help as and when needed for this programme.

MCA secretary P. Prakasa Rao, a practising medical doctor, said that 1,000 doses of vaccine had been administered, and on Tuesday doctors from Repalle – N.B. Rajendra Prasad, K. Rajeswara Rao and Radha Krishna Murthy – and the MCA relief team members accomplished the task in Pesaralanka .
